The Macedon Ranges wine region includes over 40 boutique family owned wineries offering small batch, high quality wines in an iconic location—less than an hour from Melbourne.

We may be less well known than other wine regions, but that doesn't stop us from producing some of the best cool climate wines in Australia. With vineyards at altitudes ranging from 300-800 metres, we're the coolest mainland winegrowing region in Australia - making it an ideal location for a number of varietals.

Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Sparkling Wines are what we're most known for—and

we do those exceptionally well—but that's not all we make. In the northern part of the region, you'll also find big, robust reds including Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon, and in much of the region, a number of aromatic whites, like Riesling and Gewürztraminer.

It may be the coolest wine region in mainland Australia, but you'll find a warm welcome and unpretentious cellar doors. In fact, you're likely to have your glass filled by the winemakers themselves. So leave the laneways of Melbourne behind and explore the laneways of the Macedon Ranges for stunning scenery, warm hospitality and some excellent wine.

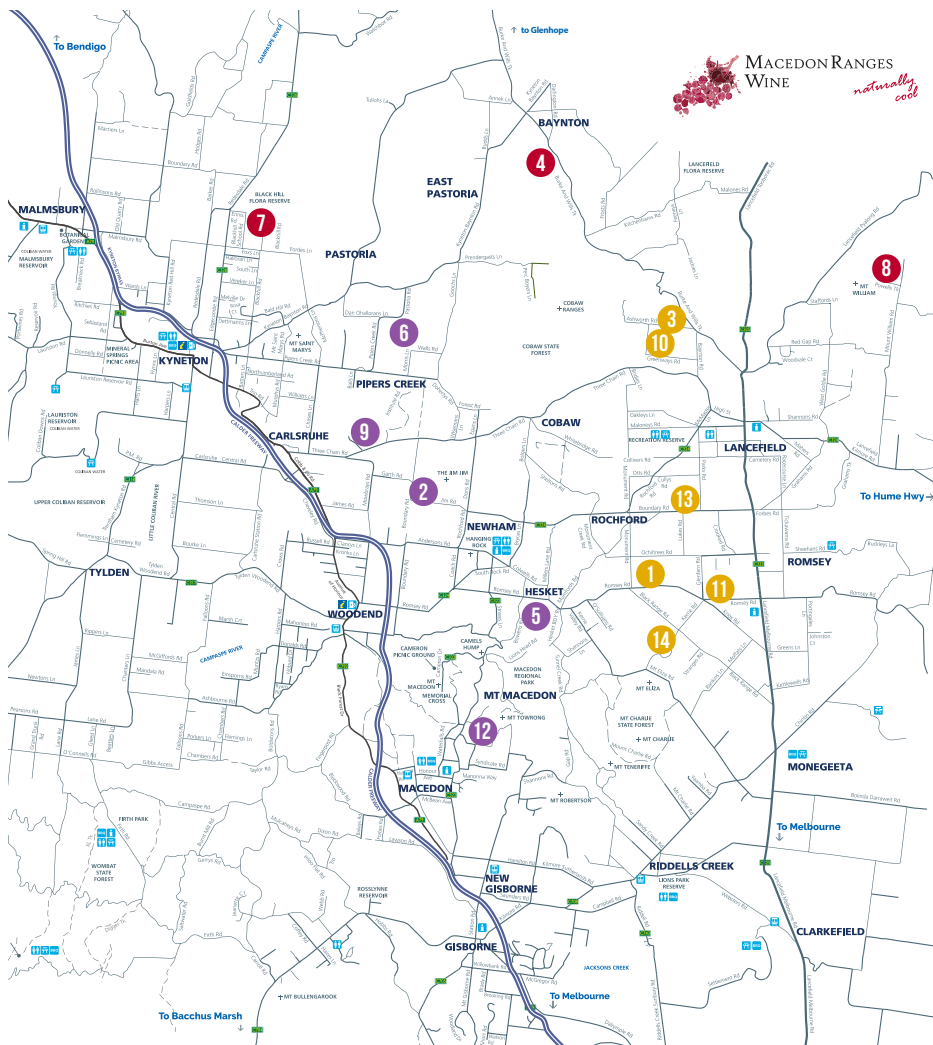

Budburst Buses

Leave the driving to someone else!

Budburst buses are a convenient way to navigate the festival, giving you stress-free flexibility and total peace of mind.

Buses are operated by friendly local drivers who will take you directly to cellar doors around the Macedon Ranges, allowing you to visit up to 5 Budburst venues, with 6+ wineries on each loop.

We have 2 Budburst bus routes on offer!

The Budburst Buses will visit 5 to 6 different festival sites originating at either Woodend Train Station or Lancefield Post Office.

Lancefield Loop

(picking up and dropping off at Lancefield Post Office and Woodend Train Station).

Woodend Wander

(picking up and dropping off at Woodend Train Station). Sponsored by Woodend Cellar & Bar.

Information on each of the Bus Loops are available on Page 26 & 27.

On **Saturday** bus routes will be operating a hop-on hop-off system with frequent buses

allowing you to navigate between 5+ budburst sites with 6+ wineries per loop at your own pace.

The hop on hop off buses allow you to enjoy flexibility and explore at your own pace. The Budburst Buses will pick you up from either Woodend Train Station or Lancefield Post Office from 10.15 to 10.30 am and deliver you to the first stop on your route for an 10:30 to 11am start to your Festival experience.

Buses will then run every 20-30 minutes around the loop so you can hop on and hop off at your leisure. Last buses will leave wineries around 4 to 4:30pm to drop you back at your starting destination around 4:30 to 5pm.

On **Sunday** take a bus for a set itinerary that means you stay with your bus for the whole day, still allowing you to visit 5+ budburst sites with 6+ wineries per loop.

The Budburst Buses will pick you up from either Woodend Train Station or Lancefield Post Office from 10.15 to 10.30 am and deliver you to the first stop on your route for an 10:30 to 11am start to your Festival experience.

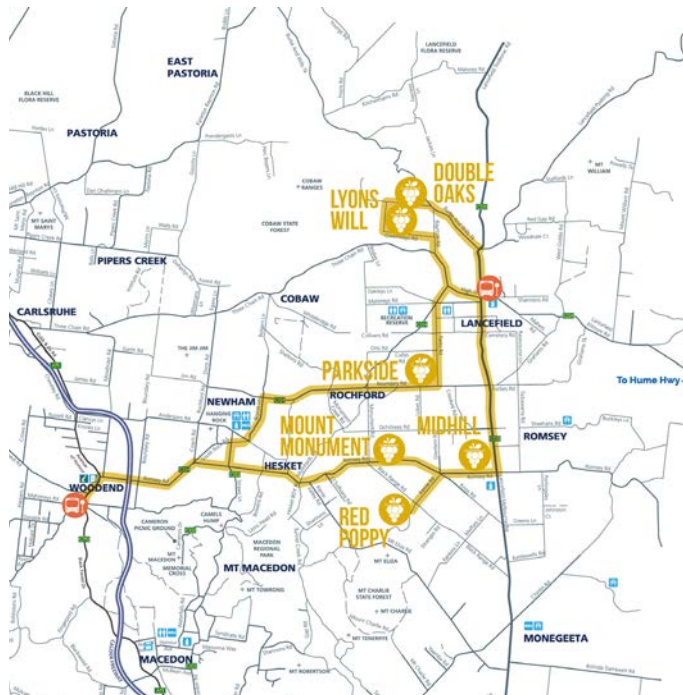
You will have 45-60min at each festival site so you can enjoy each stop with plenty of time to explore the wines. Then jump back on your bus to journey to your next stop. Buses will drop you back at your starting destination around 4:30 to 5pm.

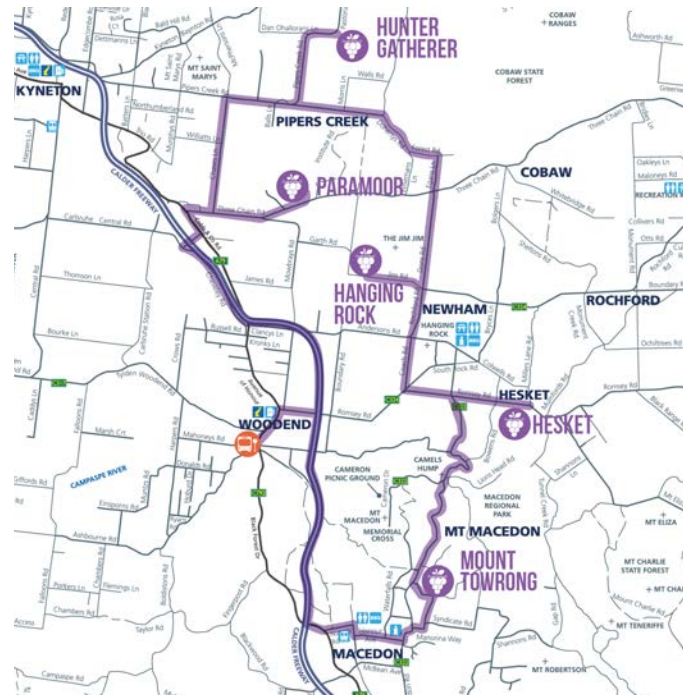
